A third of adults still can't do the basics online

Nearly one in three American adults lacks the digital skills needed for today's jobs, benefits, healthcare portals and banking. The gap falls hardest on seniors, low-income households, and workers displaced from roles that never required a computer. The cost is real: missed job applications, unclaimed benefits, and hundreds of millions lost annually to online scams that target people who were never taught what a phishing email looks like.

Digital Foundations™ closes that gap.

It is the digital literacy program of The Luc Cochran Foundation: a complete, self-paced online learning platform written for people who are starting at the very beginning. Every term is defined the first time it appears. Every lesson is short, illustrated with screenshots, and followed by a knowledge check that explains the answer instead of grading you.

Enroll, sign in, and start learning

1 Enroll through TLCF

A learner or partner organization enrolls through The Luc Cochran Foundation. The one-time program fee is \$50.

2 Access within 48 hours

The learner's account is activated within 48 hours of enrollment. There is no public sign-up and no open registration.

3 Sign in without a password

Learners sign in with a secure link sent to their email — nothing to remember, nothing to reset.

4 Learn at your own pace

Progress saves automatically. Stop mid-lesson, come back next week, pick up exactly where you left off.

5 Earn a verifiable certificate

Finish a course and earn a certificate with a public verification link an employer can check.

Verifiable certificates

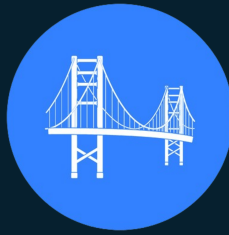
