Mission

The Luc Cochran Foundation expands access to technology, education, and opportunity for students and families in metro Atlanta, removing the practical barriers that keep people from reaching the next step.

What we do

TLCF runs five interlocking programs. Each addresses a different barrier, and participants frequently move between them: a family that comes for food assistance may leave with a working laptop and a tutoring schedule.

Our programs

Digital Foundations

Digital skills and device literacy training, delivered through our own hosted course platform with 89+ courses covering computer basics, internet safety, email, productivity software, mobile devices, and job-search technology.

Scholars Tutoring

One-on-one and small-group academic tutoring and mentorship for K-12 students, with an emphasis on math and reading confidence.

Resume Workshop

Career-readiness coaching: resume building, interview practice, job-search strategy, and workplace expectations for youth and young adults.

Nourish Network

Food access and emergency household support delivered with partner food recovery organizations and retailers.

Connect Mobile

Connectivity and device access support that helps families get online at home, at school, and at work.
